VISION

We knew, after Foundations 1, that we had to do another one.

TEACHING

The story of the Jews and the origins of the conflict in the Middle East are very confusing to most of us. This is why we have prepared very visual presentations, using maps and Powerpoint (even drama!), to explain all. We promise you many surprises and revelations!

WHAT IS FOUNDATIONS 2?

In a nutshell, it's for those who feel a calling or a curiosity about Israel, the Jewish people and their connection to the Church and individual Christians. Whether you are a veteran (in which case be prepared to share some of your knowledge) or a newcomer, the programme will have something for you, as we explore these important issues with like-minded people in a relaxing environment.

In our discussions, we will focus on three questions:

- 1. How do we share these Hebraic teachings with our fellow Christians?
- 2. How do we effectively pray for Israel and the Jewish people?
- 3. How do we teach the UK Church to understand Israel and the Jewish people?

The five days will include:

- teaching from Chris Hill, one of the most experienced Bible teachers in the UK, speaking on subjects dear to his heart.
- multimedia seminars from Steve Maltz, the most prolific author in the UK on Israel and the Church.
- group discussions led by Saffron Planet, the award-winning Christian web discussion team.
- small informal discussion groups to help us to network with other like-minded people
- lots of time for relaxation and fun, fellowship and chilling out. There's plenty of leisure activities at Quinta.
- Either just soak in the discussions and teaching, or bring your gifts and knowledge and take a more active role. Expect the unexpected as the Holy Spirit leads us into exciting places.
- Come as an individual or a church group and benefit from mixing with like-minded Christians from a variety of fellowships.
- Lots of surprises planned and special features, including workshops, displays, film shows, presentations, drama, Passover seder night, building of Succot booths etc.

OTHER THINGS YOU MAY WANT TO KNOW

- Hopefully you'll agree that the cost of the week is very reasonable. One reason is that Quinta is a tad
 more basic than other pricier Christian conference centres. Although some rooms are ensuite, most are
 not, though all have basins. Also you'll have to bring your own towels and soap and bed linen (though
 that can be provided by Quinta for a £6 surcharge). Having said that, the standard of cleanliness is very
 high, the staff are very responsive and the facilities in the conference centre include a pool table and
 table football! (There's also an outside pool for the warmer times of the year).
- Quinta is usually inhabited by Church groups or youth groups, which means that the bedrooms are arranged accordingly. This means that many rooms have double and single beds, even bunk beds in a few cases. This gives us a unique challenge as we will be folk from all over the place who in most cases will not know each other. Yet we need to fill up the bedrooms in the most efficient manner. So ...
 - Married couples in a double bed will not find themselves sharing their room with any others (unless they have other family members who don't mind sharing that would certainly help us!)
 - If you are coming with a friend (of the same sex), expect to be sharing a room with them (in single beds!)
 - If you are coming by yourself we would ideally need you to share a room with a stranger, although we will take age and compatibility into consideration, according to the information you send us. If this is a REAL problem then we can accommodate a small number in their own rooms, but there will be a single room supplement of £40 to pay.
- If you plan to come by public transport, the nearest station is Gobowen, which is about 3 miles away. There are regular trains to Gobowen from Birmingham, Cardiff, Shrewsbury, Chester and Holyhead. More at http://ojp.nationalrail.co.uk/service/ldbboard/dep/GOB. Free shuttle service available from station – arrange with us beforehand!
- If the costs of the conference are a bit high for you particularly if you are coming as a family there
 are some lower-cost options, either involving the availability of cheaper accommodation in the grounds
 for small groups or families, or, if we can create a small team for meal-time chores (i.e. setting and
 clearing tables, washing up), then those folk will have a fee reduction this may be a limited offer so
 don't hesitate to ask more about this ASAP.
